ITEM NO. 1: CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Mincer called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm opening with the Pledge of Allegiance. He announced that there would be an Executive Session following the Public Comment Period to discuss current litigation.

ITEM NO. 2: APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION was made by Kerry Welsh, seconded by Thomas Mincer, and unanimously carried to approve the July 1, 2014 Minutes as presented.

ITEM NO. 3: OLD BUSINESS

A) Maple Park Zoning Discrepancies

The Board received a Memo from Chris Wood outlining two zoning discrepancies and one sewage concern. He noted that there appears to be changes in the species of trees planted, and that approximately 30 trees are missing from the boundary line. There was a fence installed into the absorption area of the sewage mound. The Board directed that a letter requiring the shortage of tree plantings and the fence in the sewage system be addressed.

ITEM NO. 3(B):

Lake Adventure Water Tower Land Development Condition met Karen Kleist reported that Lake Adventure has met the Final Land Development approval condition of moving the access gate to the water tower to an alignment approved by the fire department. The maps can now be signed.

A) Parks & Recreation Commission

The Board received a Memo from the Rec Board requesting the date for the fall event being planned be set for Saturday September 20, 2014. Dingman-Delaware Little League and Easter Pike Soccer attended the last Commission meeting; a summary of the discussions was provided to the Board.

Park Ordinance Enforcement

Karen Kleist informed the Board that one of the Park employees noted a vehicle driving through the Park at an excessive speed (he estimated 50 mph). Can anything be done? Karen stated that the Ordinance states it is a violation for any person to drive recklessly or exceed the posted speed limit. Discussion ensued recarding the issues: the Board will give the matter further thought.

A) Pike County Library

community system and two individual systems (all drip irrigation).
