ITEM NO. 1: CALL TO ORDER	Vice Chairman Brink called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm opening with the Pledge of Allegiance. He announced that tonight's meeting is a postponement of the January 16th meeting due to inclement weather. he also announced that there would be an Executive Session immediately following the Public Comment Period to discuss Personnel matters.
ITEM ND. 2: APPROVAL OF MINUTES	MOTION was made by Ed Nikles, seconded by Dennis Brink, and unanimously carried to approve the January 2, 2018 Organization Meeting and January 2, 2018 Regular meeting, and to table approval of the December 19, 2017 Minutes until the next meeting.
ITEM ND. 3: OLD BUSINESS A) Firefighter/EMS Reimbursement Policy	The Board reviewed the final draft of the Policy to reimburse volunteers of the Dingman and Milford Fire Departments for mileage and clothing expenses, up to \$250 annually. No public comment was received. MOTION was made by Ed Nikles, seconded by Dennis Brink, and unanimously carried to approve and adopt the Firefighter/EMS Reimbursement Policy final draft as submitted.
ITEM ND. 3(B): Planning Commission Annual Report	The Board reviewed the 2017 Annual Report of the Planning Commission. 25 projects were reviewed. MOTION was made by Ed Nikles, seconded by Dennis Brink, and unanimously carried to approve the Planning Commission Annual Report for 2017 as submitted.

The Board made the following appointments: MOTION was made by Dennis Brink, seconded by Ed Nikles, and unanimously carried to appoint Glen DeLeeuw to fill the term of George Kleist on the Parks & Recreation Commission, to expire 12/31/19; MOTION was made by Dennis Brink, seconded by Ed Nikles, and unanimously carried to appoint Theo Balu to fill the unexpired term of Ed Nikles on the Diserce Commission to expire 12/21/19; and MOTION was made by Dennis Brink, seconded
	the Planning Commission, to expire on 12/31/18; and MOTION was made by Ed Nikles, seconded by Dennis Brink, and unanimously carried to appoint Scott Fahley to the vacancy on the Zoning Hearing Board, term to expire on 12/31/20.
