		Proposed well location
		Any existing and proposed structures
		Any existing and proposed sewage absorption areas on the subject property and distance to the proposed well
		Any existing and proposed sewage absorption areas on adjoining properties (including those across the street) and distance to the proposed well
		Any existing and proposed sewage tanks (septic, aerobic, dosing, sand-filter, etc.) on the subject property and distance to the proposed well.
		Any existing or proposed sewage tanks on adjoining properties including those across the street and distance to the proposed well
		Identify all neighboring properties by Section, Block, Lot
		If the neighboring property is undeveloped, mark the property as vacant.

Important:

- 1. If the property is less than one (1) acre in size, the plot plan must be in the form of a certified survey map, prepared by a Pennsylvania Registered Surveyor, and must contain all the above listed information.
- 2. Incomplete applications will result in delays in permit issuance.
